# PROPOSITION 54: Public Display of Bills Prior to Vote

## Proposition 54:

Require that every bill is published in print and online at least 72 hours before each house of the legislature can vote on it



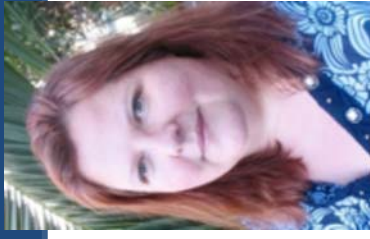

## YES, you can lobby on Ballot Measures

1. Publicly endorse or oppose measures
2. Organize volunteers to gather signatures
3. Pay staff to gather signatures
4. Contribute or loan money to campaigns
5. Host campaign events
6. Register voters and encourage them to vote yes  
or no on a specific measure
7. Propose and draft a ballot measure

## Compliance

1. Do not support or oppose candidates.
2. Measure and report lobbying activities.
  - Insubstantial Part Test (measures the percent of activity an organization spends on lobbying) OR
  - 501 (h) Expenditure Test (measures how much money an organization spends on lobbying)

# PROPOSITION 64: Legalizing recreational marijuana

Legalizes recreational marijuana and hemp under state law and establishes certain sales and cultivation taxes

# PROPOSITION 62 & 66: Death Penalty

## Propositions 62 and 66:

If both pass, the one with the most “yes” votes would supercede the other.

# PROPOSITION 59: Advisory to overturn Citizens United Act



## Proposition 59:

Instructs California elected officials use their authority to overturn the Citizens United decision, potentially through an amendment to the U.S. Constitution

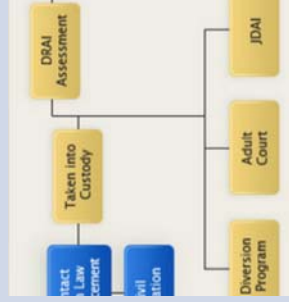
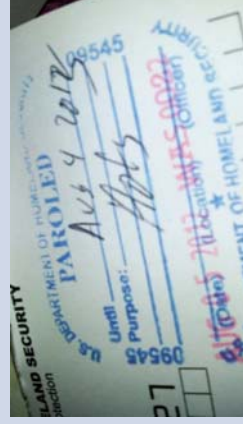
## Prop 52
